We have identified a leak at Swimming Pool, The Quay, Emerald, Quay, Shoreham, BN435JP. The water leak is on the water supply pipe for the swimming pool or the internal pipe work related to the pool. We've estimated the leak at 255 LPH.

What happens next?

The Water Industry Act 1991 requires us to ask that you repair the leak within 30 days of receiving this letter, which is {date_wn21_end}, because the leak is likely to cause damage, or result in the water we supply being wasted, misused or becoming contaminated.

If the leak isn't repaired

If you don't carry out the repair, the Water Industry Act 1991 enables us to:

- cut off the supply if the leak becomes an emergency or the property appears unoccupied¹
- carry out the repair and charge you a reasonable cost for the work
- prosecute² you for allowing your water fittings to be or remain defective.

We will, however, send a waste notice before we take any of these steps; this can be avoided if you keep us updated with progress.
